Having fears is our nature. However, if your fear of something becomes too strong and causes trouble in your life, you might have a phobia. Here are some examples. People with cynophobia (fear of dogs) get scared when they see a dog and when they think of dogs. They might stay in the house all day just to avoid seeing dogs. Phobias like claustrophobia (fear of small spaces) and acrophobia (fear of heights) are also very common.
